



- All 501(c)3 parishes, schools and ministries, listed in the Official Catholic Directory within the three participating dioceses
- Includes Catholic parishes, schools, ministries, apostolates, and religious orders
- Must be able to accept ACH direct deposit transfers to a valid checking account

- Gifts are given through #iGiveCatholic, a registered fundraiser in every state, to your organization using the GiveGab platform technology















Simple Donation Form

- Direct debit via "Bank Account" option and log into your bank
- Securely processed via Stripe PCI Level 1 Compliant Processor



Transparent Donation Processing



- Donors can opt-out of covering all fees on behalf of your organization
- Fee information is front and center, and live-calculates
- Donors can anonymize gifts, donate in honor or in memory of, and more!



Immediate Donor Thank You

- Automatic Thank You Emails via #iGiveCatholic for all online gifts
- Sent immediately after the gift is made
- Serves as a tax-deductible receipt
- Offline receipting must be handled separately

Pro Tip: Be sure to follow up with a more personal thank you!


